

Thames Sailing Barge REPERTOR 2012 Summary Sailing Programme

Based at St Katharine's Dock, London and in Faversham, Kent, **SB Repertor** is available for sailing charters, from May to October. Our sailing programme is arranged around Barge Matches (races) and the passage trips before and afterwards - see dates on left. Or you can book other dates and locations for your own choice of daysails, weekends or longer trips. Please see our website or contact us direct for availability.

Individual or Group Bookings

SB Repertor can take up to 12 passengers maximum for sailing charters - as individuals or in groups.

Confirmation of trips depends on location and a minimum total of 8 passengers booked - we can often join individuals and smaller groups with others to make up numbers.

- Sailings and timings are always subject to the weather, tides and the skipper's discretion
- Catering starts from breakfast or lunch, as appropriate, on the day of sailing
- B & B over-night before day-trips is usually available at £25 each. Two-day and longer trips may include B & B over-night before sailing
- Charter locations which require special transfer passages may incur additional charges
- For trips which include a Match, numbers are limited to 8 passengers for the race day itself

Conditions of Booking

Bookings and Fees

In order for a booking to be confirmed, a deposit of 25% of the total charter fee should be paid.

The balance of the total charter fee should be paid not less than 4 weeks before the start of the charter.

To confirm bookings made less than 4 weeks before the date of the charter, the full charter fee should be paid.

Insurance and Safety

The insurance and maintenance of SB Repertor is the responsibility of the vessel's owners. SB Repertor is fully insured and equipped with life-saving and fire-fighting equipment, in accordance with standards regulated by the Maritime and Coastguard Agency (MCA).

In all other aspects of the charter and safety of SB Repertor, her passengers and crew, the decision of the skipper is final.

Cancellation by the Passenger

If any passenger cancels their place(s) on a charter, the deposit booking fee is non-refundable. If the cancellation takes place less than 4 weeks before the start of the charter, the passenger is liable to pay the full amount of the charter fee.

Cancellation by the Owner or Agent

All charter trips are dependent on a minimum number of 8 passengers booking places on them. In the event of a minimum of eight places not being booked by 2 weeks before the start of the charter, the Owner/ Agent may decide to cancel the charter and to return all fees deposited to passengers who have booked. Every effort will be made to carry out charters, as described but, in the event of adverse weather conditions, it may be necessary to change or curtail the planned itinerary. If it is possible to give 2 or more days notice of enforced cancellation, all charter fees deposited will be refunded. Wherever possible, passengers will be offered alternative charter dates and, if agreed, then all fees deposited will be carried over to the new charter date. If passengers arrive for the charter and, in the skipper's opinion, it is unsafe to depart, no refund will be made, but the barge, her crew and all catering to be provided for the charter will remain at the disposal of the passengers. No liability will be accepted by the Owner/ Agent for expense or compensation arising from enforced cancellation of the charter or change of itinerary.

Typical Sailing Charters

East Coast Rivers Cruises

Daysails, Weekends, 3-day, 4-day or 5-day trips
Sailing from London (O2), Faversham, Whitstable, Maldon, Brightlingsea, Ipswich or Mistley; exploring the Kent, Essex or Suffolk Rivers and the Thames Estuary.

Possible ports-of-call

Chatham and Stangate Creek on the Medway;
Queenborough, Harty, Hollowshore and Whitstable on the Swale; Maldon and West Mersea on the Blackwater;
Brightlingsea and Wivenhoe on the Colne; Orford, Snape and Aldeburgh on the Ore and Alde; Walton Backwaters; Woodbridge on the Deben; Mistley, Shotley and Harwich on the Stour; Pin Mill and Ipswich on the Orwell.
Or along the London River via Southend, Gravesend, Greenhithe and the Woolwich Barrier to the O2 Arena.

Barge Matches

We are keen competitors and often successful - Repertor has been Champion Barge in 5 out of the past 12 years. For 2012 race dates, see overleaf - total numbers are usually limited to 8 passengers for the race day itself.

General Interest, Art and Photography Cruises

For example, a daysail including a trip around the new Wind Farm and World War 2 Maunsell Forts off Whitstable; or a weekend around the Isle of Sheppey, into the Medway and the Swale, under the Kingsferry Bridges and through The Grounds to local pubs at Harty or Hollowshore; or to overnight anchorages with sunset views over the marshes.

Breweries Cruises

Including brewery tours (by arrangement) and runs ashore to waterside pubs for local brews.
