SPECIAL INTEREST TRIPS

Barge Matches (Races) – *We are keen competitors and often successful – SB Repertor was Champion Barge in 2007, 2006, 2003, 2000 and 1999. Join us the day before to help us tune up – or stay on for the day after to help us unwind! Numbers are usually limited to 8 passengers for the race day – for dates and prices for the 9 Barge Matches during the season, see overleaf.*

East Coast Rivers Cruises – *Daysails, Weekends, 3-day, 4-day or 5-day trips. Sailing from Faversham, Whitstable, Maldon, Brightlingsea or Mistley; exploring the Kent, Essex or Suffolk Rivers and Thames Estuary. Possible ports-of-call: Chatham and Stangate Creek on the Medway; Queenborough, Harty, Hollowshore and Whitstable on the Swale; Maldon and West Mersea on the Blackwater; Brightlingsea and Wivenhoe on the Colne; Orford, Snape and Aldeburgh on the Ore and Alde; Walton Backwaters; Woodbridge on the Deben; Mistley, Shotley and Harwich on the Stour; Pin Mill and Ipswich on the Orwell. Or up the London River via Southend, Gravesend, Greenhithe and Greenwich to the heart of The City.*

Art, Photography and General Interest Cruises – *for example, a daysail including a trip around the new Wind Farm and World War 2 Maunsell Forts off Whitstable; or around the Isle of Sheppey, into the Swale, under the Kingsferry Bridges and through The Grounds to local pubs at Harty or Hollowshore; or to overnight anchorages with sunset views across the marshes.*

Breweries Cruise – *including brewery tours (by arrangement) and runs ashore for local brews.*

Clay Pigeon Shooting Afloat – *Under expert safety-certified supervision (additional fee).*

Walk-and-Sail Cruises – *routes, guide maps and descriptions available.*

Birdwatching Cruises – *with expert Wildlife Trust guidance available (additional fee).*

NOTES

- Confirmation of trips depends on location and minimum 8 total passengers booked.
- Sailings and timings are all subject to weather, tides and skipper's discretion.
- Catering starts from breakfast or lunch on day of sailing.
- B & B over-night before day-trips is usually available at £30 each.
- Two-day and longer trips may include B & B over-night before sailing.
- For trips including a Match, numbers are usually limited to 8 passengers for the race day.
- For corporate rates and passage trips (usually £50 each), please enquire when booking.
- Prices for some start/ finish locations may require an out-of-station supplement.
